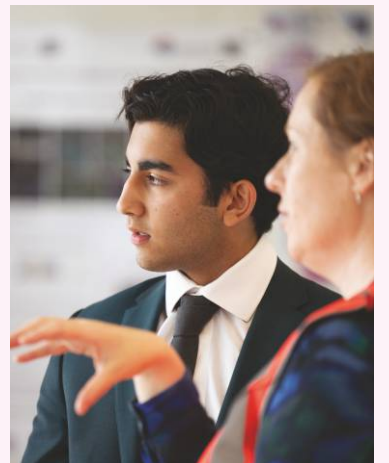




# State-of-the-art 'Cyrus Poonawalla Vaccines Research Building' at The University of Oxford, UK.

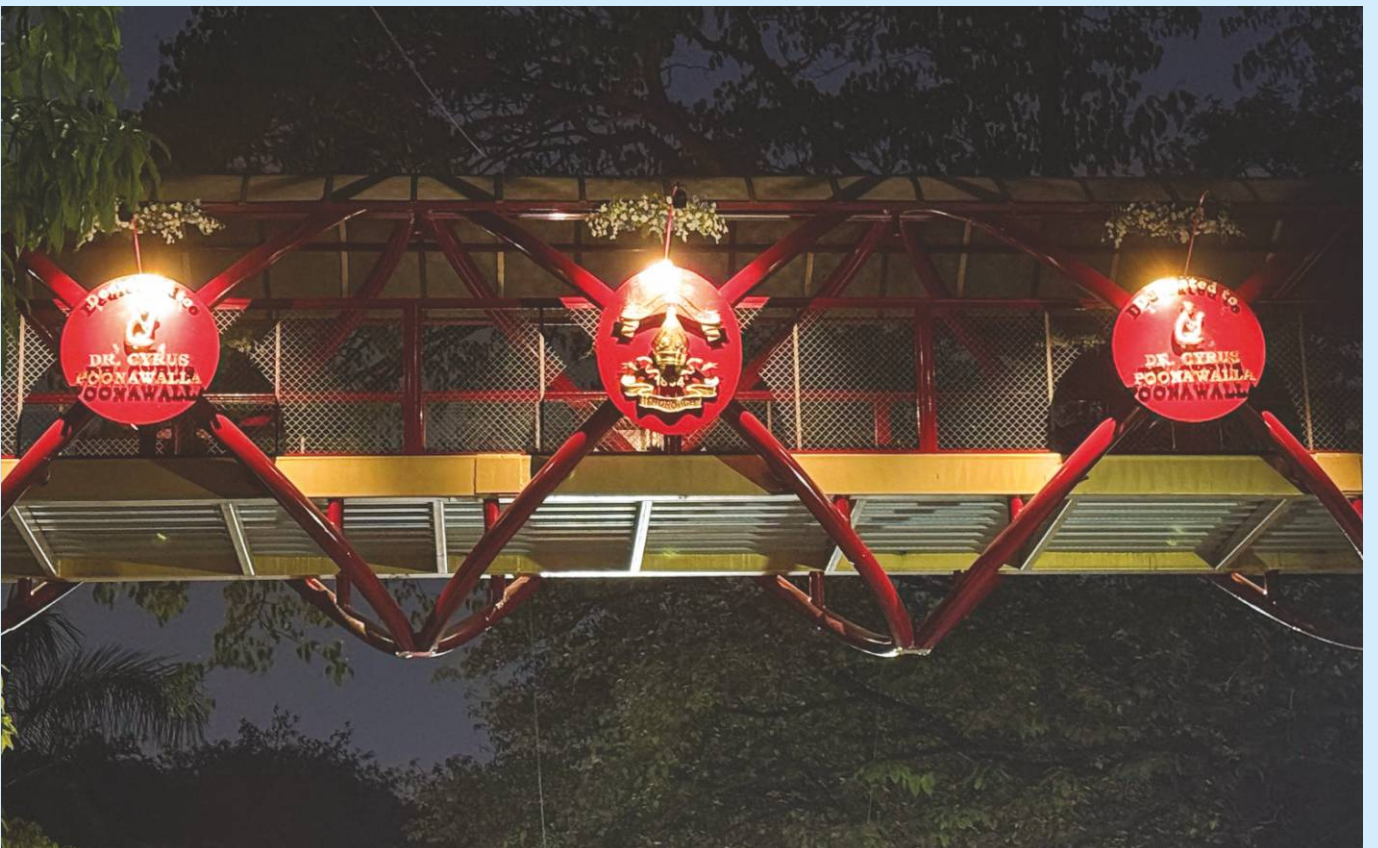




## The BISHOP'S School Foot Overbridge

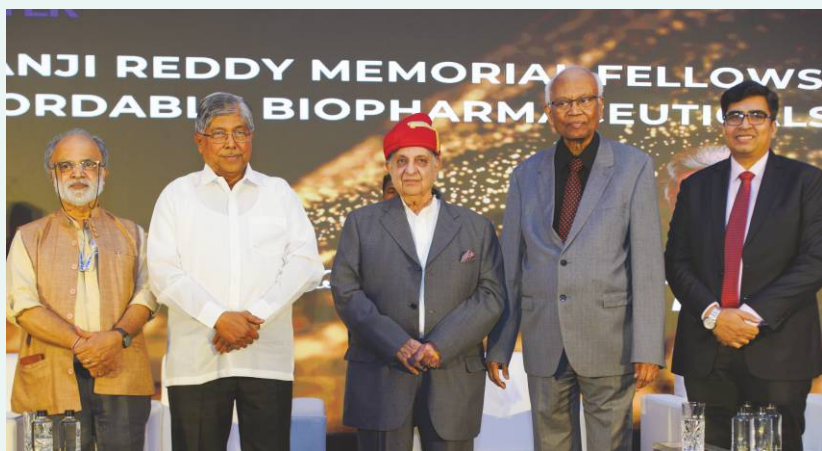

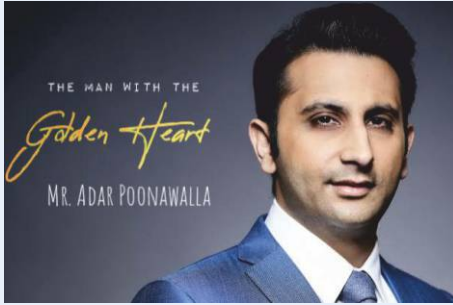




## Empowering Transgender Communities.

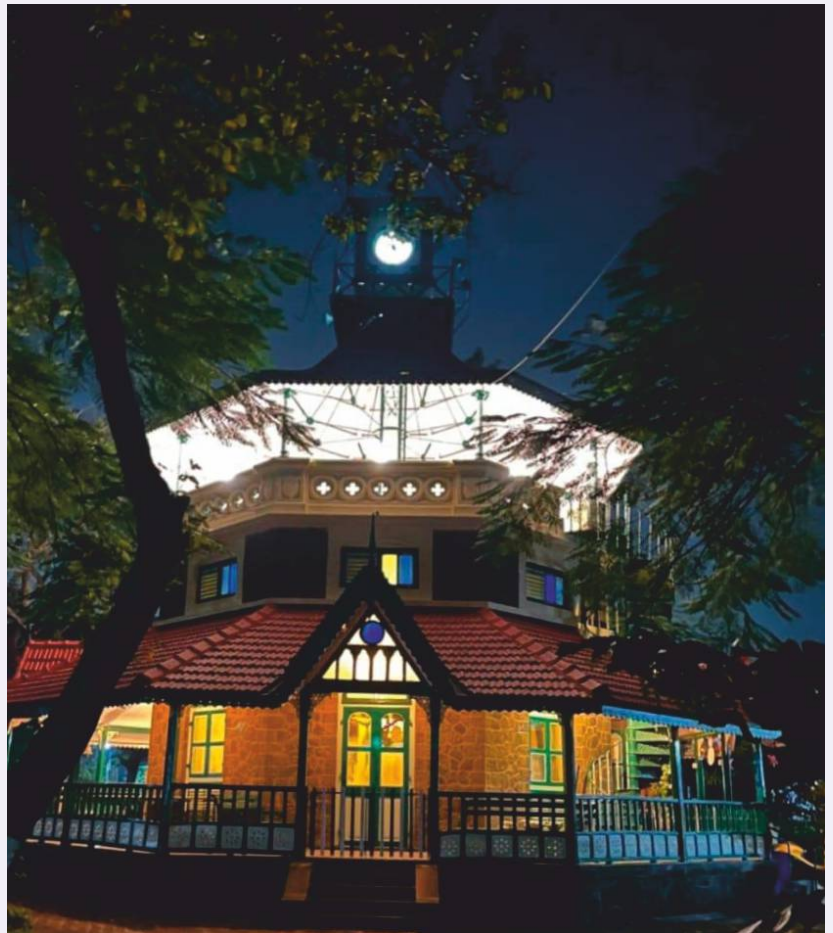




## Dr K N Bahadurji Memorial Sanatorium for Parsis, Nashik

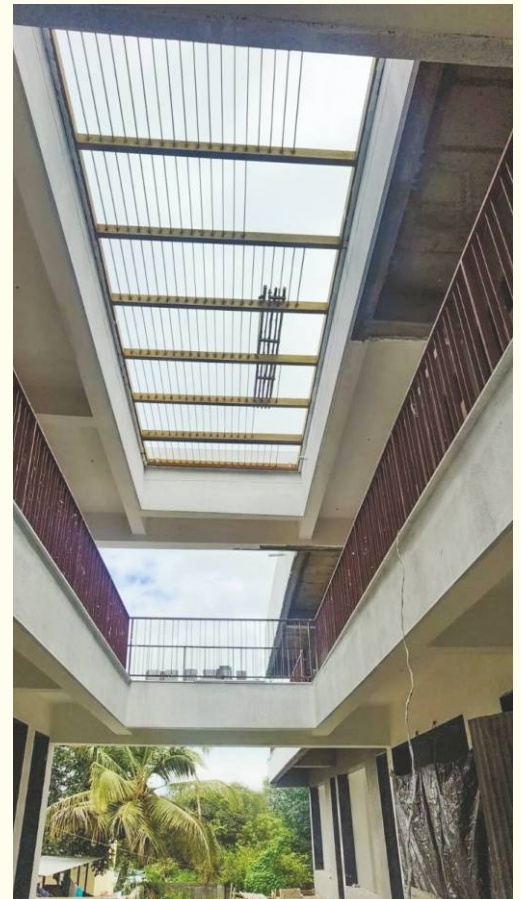




## Dr. Cyrus Poonwalla High School & Junior College

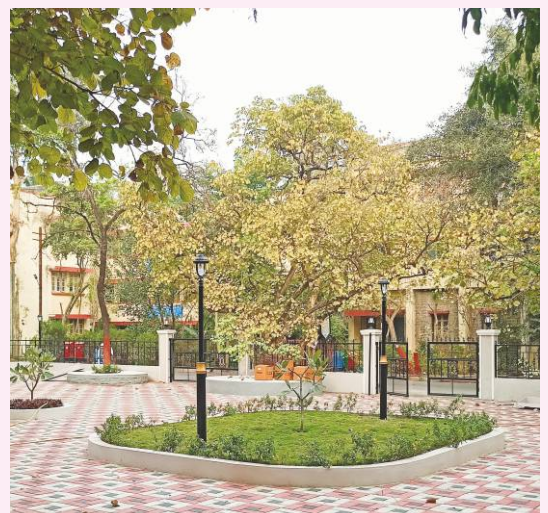
## SNVT Women's University, Pune

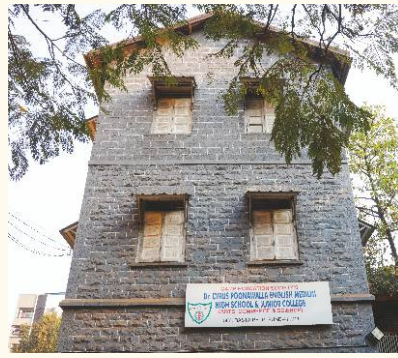
## Dr. Cyrus Poonawalla Skill Development Centre (Camp)

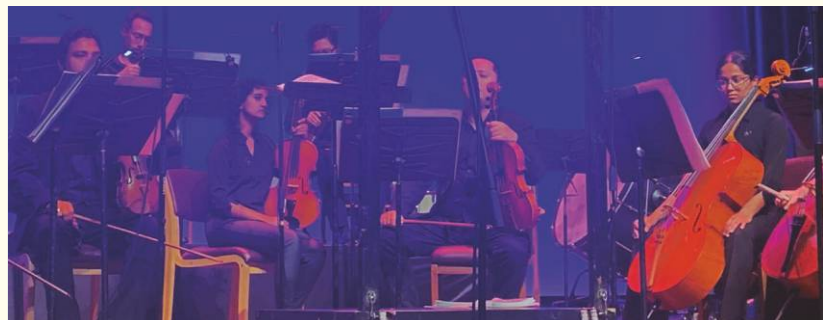
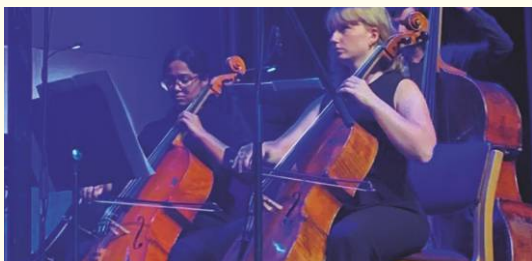

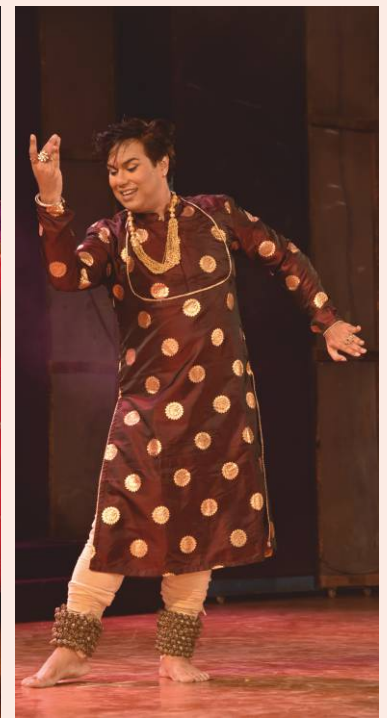
## Saheli, HIV / Aids Karya Karta Sangh

Saheli — a community based Female Sex Workers Collective founded in 1998, based in Pune, Maharashtra, committed to resolving the issues and concerns of women in sex work with a rights-based approach. A community that was initially formed with 9 members, today stands strong with 1500 members and has successfully empowered over 1000 women. Committed leadership towards creating a conducive environment to eliminate all forms of stigma against people affected by HIV/AIDS, advocate

for their inclusivity in society and a vision to empower female sex workers has led Saheli Sangh to be the only female sex workers collective active in 12 districts across Maharashtra.

The Viloo Poonawalla Foundation (VPF) has supported Saheli in its efforts to empower women and promote gender equality. VPF has provided financial and technical support to help Saheli expand its reach and impact, and to develop and implement programs that address the needs of women in India. VPF helps create jobs for elderly former sex workers to promote economic and social empowerment, reduce vulnerability, and improve overall well-being. The children of these sex workers are offered education in Viloo Poonawalla High School and training at the Skill Centre.

VPF's support for Saheli is part of the foundation's broader commitment to improving the lives of people in India. Through its work with Saheli, VPF seeks to empower women and promote gender equality, creating a more equitable and just world for all.







## Foundation for Child Protection, Muskaan

Foundation for Child Protection-Muskaan is an NGO working to prevent Child Sexual Abuse (CSA) and help survivors since the year 2000. Muskaan is the only initiative in Pune whose entire focus is on the critical issue of CSA, addressing it with a multi-disciplinary approach, involving prevention, case work, counselling, police support, legal aid, healing Services and community intervention. We focus not only on children, but on all involved stakeholders, viz., parents, relatives, teachers, police, lawyers and child

protection agencies. We also work with children staying in Child Care Institutions (CCIs) in need of care and protection as well as children in conflict with the law at Observation Homes to expedite the process of rehabilitation and restoration of their lost childhood. Free legal aid- Our In-house lawyer and the dedicated law firms provide free legal assistance to CSA survivors till the judgement is given. They also prepare survivors for court appearances and support public prosecutors to handle the cases. Currently they are assisting 97 cases of CSA survivors legally.





## British Asian Trust, India

British Asian Trust is supporting thousands of marginalised women to build resilience against poverty. With their support they are gaining economic empowerment through increased access to finance, learning about financial management and seeking control of resources. 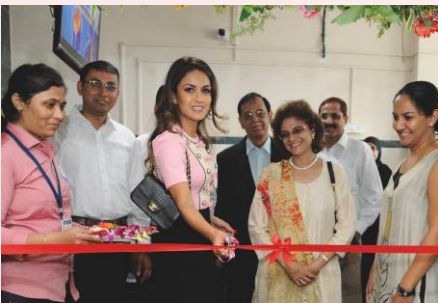


## Viloo Poonawalla Memorial Hospital, Hadapsar, Pune

## Environment Sustainability Free Filter Potable Water Project

We've always believed that access to clean water is not just a basic need but a fundamental right. In 2017, we set out to make this right a reality for underserved communities in the eastern part of Pune, encompassing areas such as Manjari, Phursungi, Loni, Theur and beyond. Understanding the critical need for safe, potable water, we introduced a pioneering Hub and Spoke model to ensure that even the most remote areas could access this vital resource. The backbone of our initiative is the network of water purification units, or hubs, equipped with state-of-the-art RO+UV+UF technologies. These hubs treat and store clean water, which is then distributed through a series of strategically placed Water ATMs, our spokes, across the region. These solar-powered, IoT-enabled Water ATMs, anchored on sturdy foundations, provide up to 20 litres of water per household each day via an RFID-tagged system.

This approach not only ensures safe drinking water but also guarantees that the water is available consistently, monitored in real-time to maintain quality and availability. Over the years, our Clean Water Supply project has grown significantly. In the fiscal year 2023-24, we expanded our capacity to provide 140,000 litres of filtered water daily, a significant increase from the previous year. With 85 Water ATMs now in operation, distributing potable drinking water to more than 8,000 Water ATM cards. This project has also generated employment opportunities, with dedicated employees managing and maintaining the clean water supply system.

Our mission is clear: to continue expanding our reach and impact, ensuring that every family in these communities has access to safe, clean, and pure drinking water.

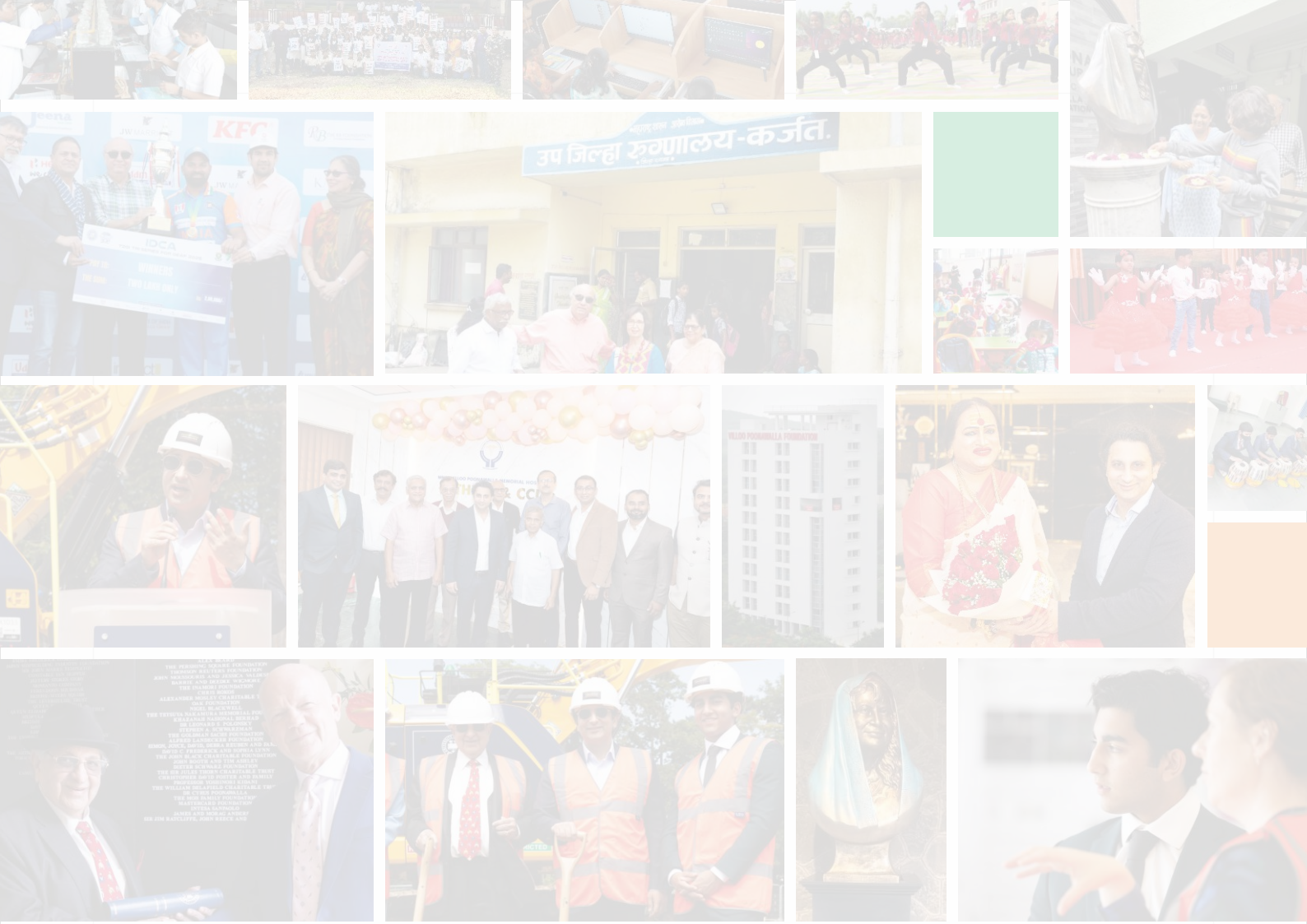
