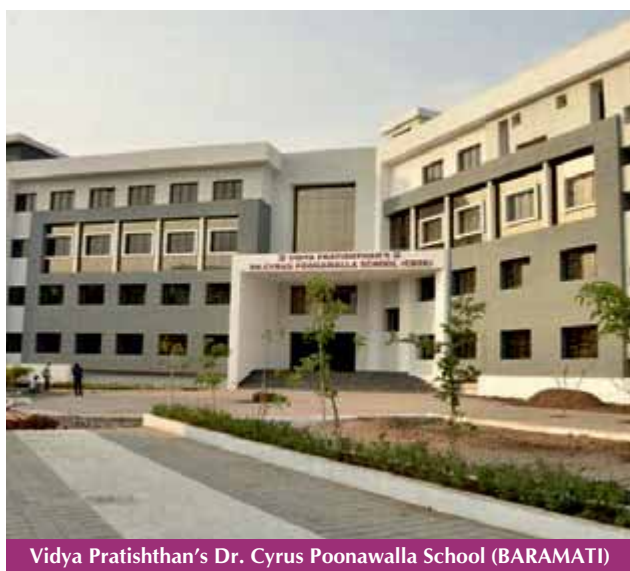

Saheli

HIV/AIDS/Sex workers and Budhwar Peth

Saheli — a community based Female Sex Workers Collective founded in 1998, based in Pune, Maharashtra, committed to resolving the issues and concerns of women in sex work with a rights-based approach. A community that was initially formed with 9 members, today stands strong with 1500 members and has successfully empowered over 1000 women. Committed leadership towards creating a conducive environment to eliminate all forms of stigma against people affected by HIV/AIDS, advocate for their inclusivity in society and a vision to empower female sex workers has led Saheli Sangh to be the only female sex workers collective active in 12 districts across Maharashtra.

The Villoo Poonawalla Foundation (VPF) has supported Saheli in its efforts to empower women

and promote gender equality. VPF has provided financial and technical support to help Saheli expand its reach and impact, and to develop and implement programs that address the needs of women in India. VPF helps create jobs for elderly former sex workers to promote economic and social

empowerment, reduce vulnerability, and improve overall well-being. The children of these sex workers are offered education in Villoo Poonawalla High School and training at the Skill Centre.

VPF's support for Saheli is part of the foundation's broader commitment to improving the lives of people in India. Through its work with Saheli, VPF seeks to empower women and promote gender equality, creating a more equitable and just world for all.



Muskaan

Muskaan - a Pune based NGO founded in 2000, focuses on the issue of Sexual Abuse of Children, a non-profit organisation in India that works to improve the lives of children living in poverty, particularly those who are marginalised and excluded from education and other basic services. The organisation provides educational and vocational training programs, as well as health and nutrition support, to help children break the cycle of poverty and build a better future for themselves.

Muskaan follows a three-pronged approach - prevention, counselling, and police & legal support. VPF supports Muskaan by funding the legal fees as well as the counselling services provided for abused children and their families, which in turn enables them to overcome their trauma.



Sayfty Self Care Summit

Sayfty Self Care Summit is a virtual event that focuses on promoting self-care and mental health awareness. It provides an opportunity for attendees to learn about various self-care practices and strategies, as well as hear from experts on how to prioritize and manage their mental health. The summit also aims to raise awareness about the importance of self-care and mental health, and to encourage individuals to prioritize their own well-being. With the support from VPF, the Sayfty Self Care Summit can bring together experts, professionals, and individuals to share their knowledge and experiences on the topic of self-care and mental health.



British Asian Trust, India

The British Asian Trust was founded in 2007 by King Charles 111 and aims to address immediate challenges that threaten the future recovery of vulnerable communities across the country. Their programmes work to reduce poverty and disadvantage for communities in South Asia. At all times, our focus is on outcomes and impact. The Trust helps children stay in school and maximise their potential, and are working with local partners on a range of programmes throughout the country. This trust works to tackle the wide spread poverty and hardships faced by the people in South Asia. It has positively impacted the lives of 6.6 million disadvantaged people in India. They also support thousands of marginalised women to build resilience against poverty. As a philanthropic organisation, VPF provided support to the Trust in the form of donations to help further its mission and initiatives in India.



Empowering Transgender Communities

Free Vaccination Drive - Parivartan Ka Teeka

Ensuring equitable vaccination accessibility, VPF, and Kineer Services via the 'Parivartan Ka Teeka' will provide free-of-cost vaccination for the transgender community nationwide.

Kineer Water Bottling Plant (PUNE)

Set up under Kineer Services, the operational drinking water plant in Wagholi, Maharashtra, run entirely by transgenders, aims to generate employment in an otherwise neglected community. Helping their cause VPF has decided to buy approximately 6000 litres of potable water supply per day to the villages nearby.

NATIONAL TRANSGENDERS CONCLAVE 2021 (Inclusiveness, Dignity and Rights)

Special National Event-the first ever conclave to engender inclusivity of transgenders and inclusiveness in our national mainstream. This was to deliberate and celebrate the community's immense potential, possibilities and talents which will contribute to our national cause.



Vir Tarapore Amrut Minar (Commemorating 75 years of India's Freedom)

Amrut Minar is a landmark Tower being built in Pune in honor of Lt Col Vir Tarapore who died a Hero's death on 16th September, 1965. The valor and bravery displayed by him was in keeping with the highest traditions of the Indian Army, for which he was posthumously awarded the Param Vir Chakra.

VPF support to build the tower will help to preserve and protect this important landmark, ensuring that future generations can enjoy its beauty and significance. Through its support for the Amrut Minar and other cultural initiatives, VPF seeks to promote a greater appreciation for India's rich history and cultural traditions.



Memorial Wall (Pune Zilla Parishad)

35 employees and officials of the Pune Zilla Parishad (ZP) lost their lives during COVID. They were all on active duty during the pandemic, either serving in hospitals or providing extension services. VPF is supporting Pune Zilla Parishad to build a memorial

for 35 staffers who died during the pandemic while undertaking efforts to curb COVID-19. VPF continues its journey of support towards all lives affected by the pandemic and hence, are a part of this initiative undertaken by the Pune Zilla Parishad.



Indian Deaf Cricket Association

The Indian Deaf Cricket Association (IDCA) is a non-profit organisation that promotes and organises cricket for deaf people in India. The IDCA aims to provide opportunities for deaf cricketers to participate in the sport at a national and international level, and to help develop the sport for the deaf community in India. The Viloo Poonawalla Foundation (VPF) supports the Indian Deaf Cricket Association (IDCA) by providing funding and resources to help the organisation promote and organise cricket for deaf people in India. The support from VPF allows IDCA to provide opportunities for deaf cricketers to participate in the sport, including training and equipment, as well as organising national and international tournaments. From a child bride to a video journalist, from rag-picking to representing India at an international conference, Maya Muktai has achieved more than many people achieve at twice her age. She joined the Kagad Kach Patra Kashtakari Panchayat in 2003 and signed up for training programmes under them. Dr. Cyrus Poonawalla gifted Maya Muktai a car, to help her commute from village to village to help villagers around Nasik.



Orphaned Topper From Bhopal, Who Lost Both Parents To Covid, Battles Loan Recovery

Vanisha Pathak who topped her board exams with 99.8% within months of losing both her parents to COVID was constantly bothered with legal notices for repayment of the loan her late father had taken from one of the leading institutions. Her struggle and hardships were noticed by VPF and hence helped her with the funding to clear her loan.

Adar Poonawalla reaches out to Bhopal's Vanisha; her home is now safe

Bhopal: Vanisha Pathak can finally breathe a sigh of relief. Her home will remain here. The schoolgirl had topped Bhopal in her class in exams in 2021 by scoring 99.8% despite losing both parents to Covid, but was being hounded with notices from a financial institution for repayment of the loan for non-repayment of EMIs. Her letters, explaining her situation and seeking some time, had gone unanswered until VPF reported about her courage and plight, requesting an outpouring of support for her.

Handsome came forward to help her. Many, including the CEO of Serum Institute Adar Poonawalla, offered to pay off the home loan but it was tangled in legal issues as Vanisha didn't have a legal guardian on paper. Even Union finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman took notice of the case and directed LJC to look into the matter as Vanisha's father had taken the home loan from LIC Housing Finance Ltd.

Vanisha lost her dad in November. And now chairman of Serum Institute of India Dr Cyrus Poonawalla, and CEO Vikas Poonawalla, have given Rs 37.27 lakh to her to clear her loans of the loan burden.

"This initiative was jointly taken by the chairman of Serum Institute of India Dr Cyrus Poonawalla and our CEO

Adar Poonawalla. They are very passionate people with a lot of compassion. They want these children now to focus on their education and be absolutely stress free. I was in constant touch with the family during the entire process," said Jeevinder Narang, CEO Vikas Poonawalla Foundation.

Vanisha said, "I am thankful to Poonawalla ji for their support in saving my home. That was the last thing we have of our loving parents. We will always be grateful to their support." She is now in class 12. Vanisha and her brother are in the care of their maternal uncle and aunt - Prof Ashok Sharma and Shweta Sharma - who recently got legal guardianship of the children from a Bhopal court. Prof Sharma said, "We are grateful to Poonawalla ji for their support. I do not have any words for the gratitude we feel."

Mumbai: Indian Medical Association

Pune: Family Planning Association of India

In India, there have been various efforts and campaigns to promote the use of vasectomy as a form of family planning, particularly as a means of reducing population growth and improving maternal and child health outcomes. the years amongst the men over the country has led to an increase in the number of males ready to undergo vasectomy and contribute towards birth control. The Vasectomy Clinic in Mumbai and Pune contribute towards this cause and help spread awareness about vasectomy and promote the same.

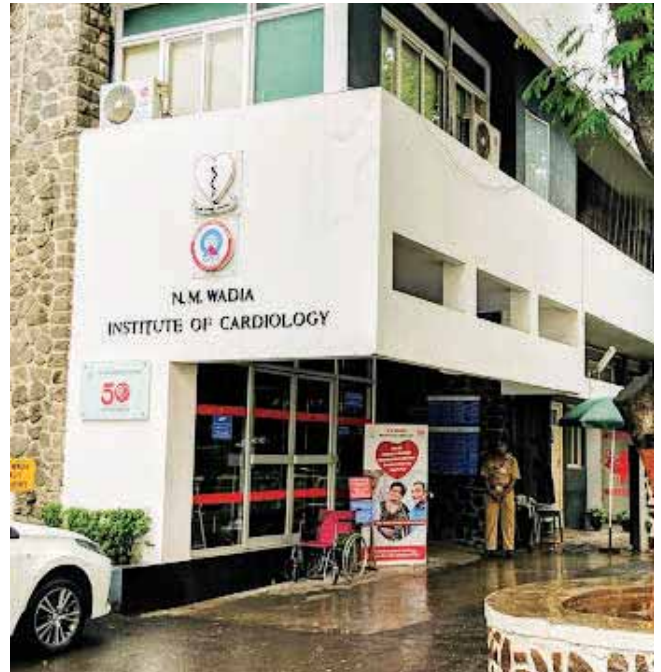



Free Filter Potable Water Project

The APCC Water Project provides clean and safe drinking water to residents of villages, in Manjari, Fursungi, and Sadestra Nali, around Pune. Raw groundwater at the Manjari plant is treated and transported to be dispensed through dispensing units popularly called Water ATMs located in villages. These ATMs provide 10 liters of water per person each day using a smart RFID card. This sees more than 2000 families from the villages of Pune receive safe water.
